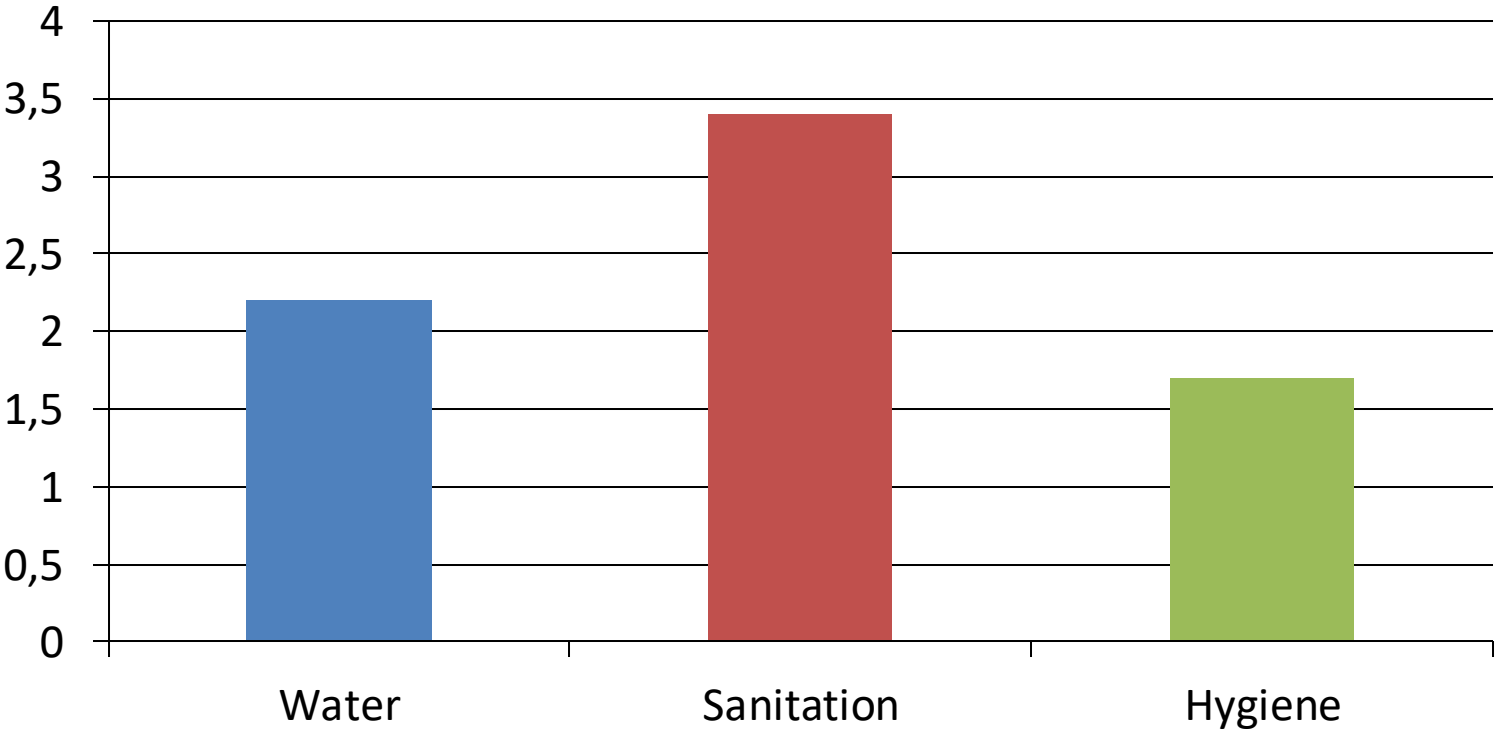

Key Global Statistics

- 2.2 billion people lack safe drinking water
- 3.4–3.5 billion lack sanitation
- 1.7 billion lack hygiene services
- 56% wastewater safely treated

Values

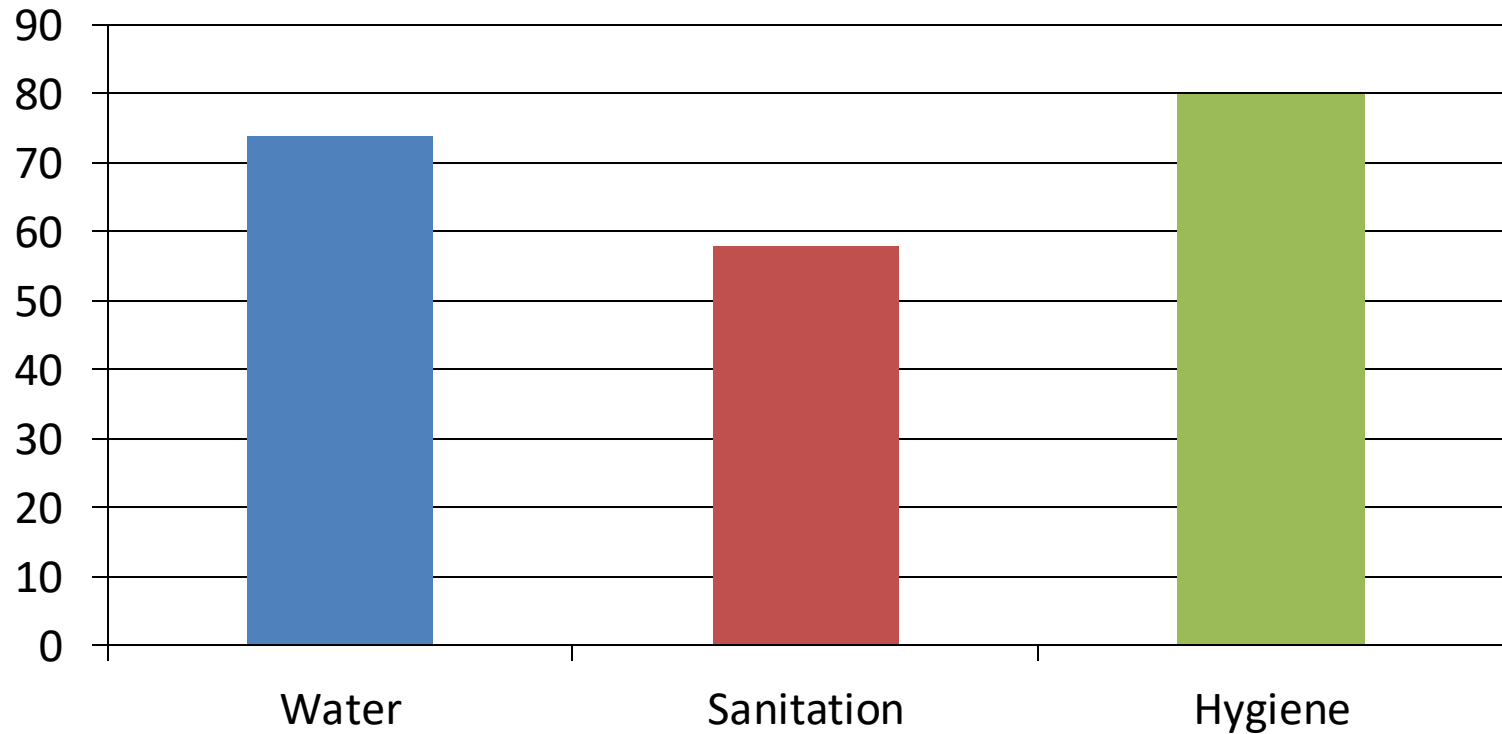


Access Progress (2015–2024)

- Water: 68% → 74%
- Sanitation: 48% → 58%
- Hygiene: 66% → 80%

Health Impact

- 300,000 child deaths annually from diarrhoea
- 1.4 million deaths linked to unsafe WASH
- Cholera outbreaks rising

Water Stress & Climate

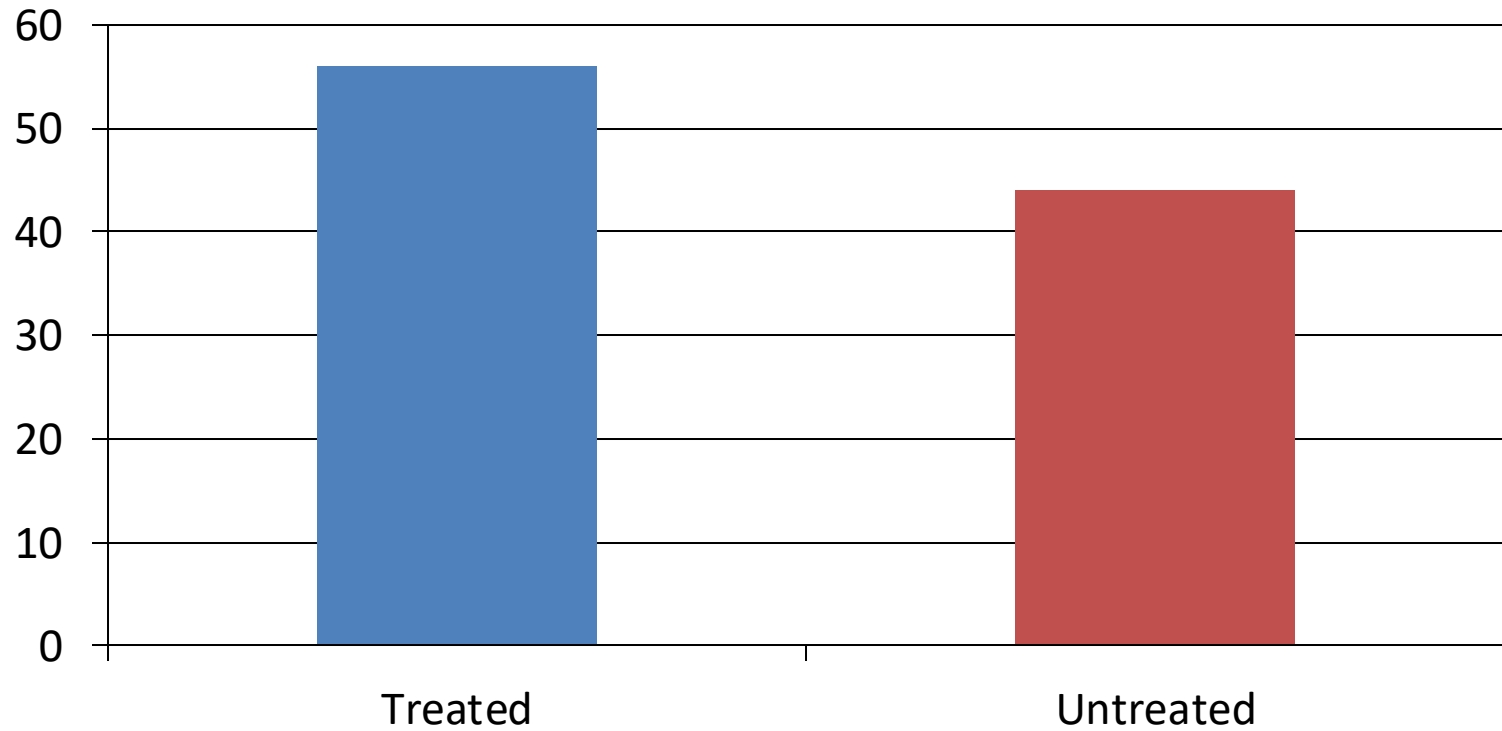
- 1.4 billion affected by droughts
- Water scarcity increasing due to climate change

Wastewater Treatment

- Only 56% of wastewater is safely treated globally

Wastewater Treatment (%)

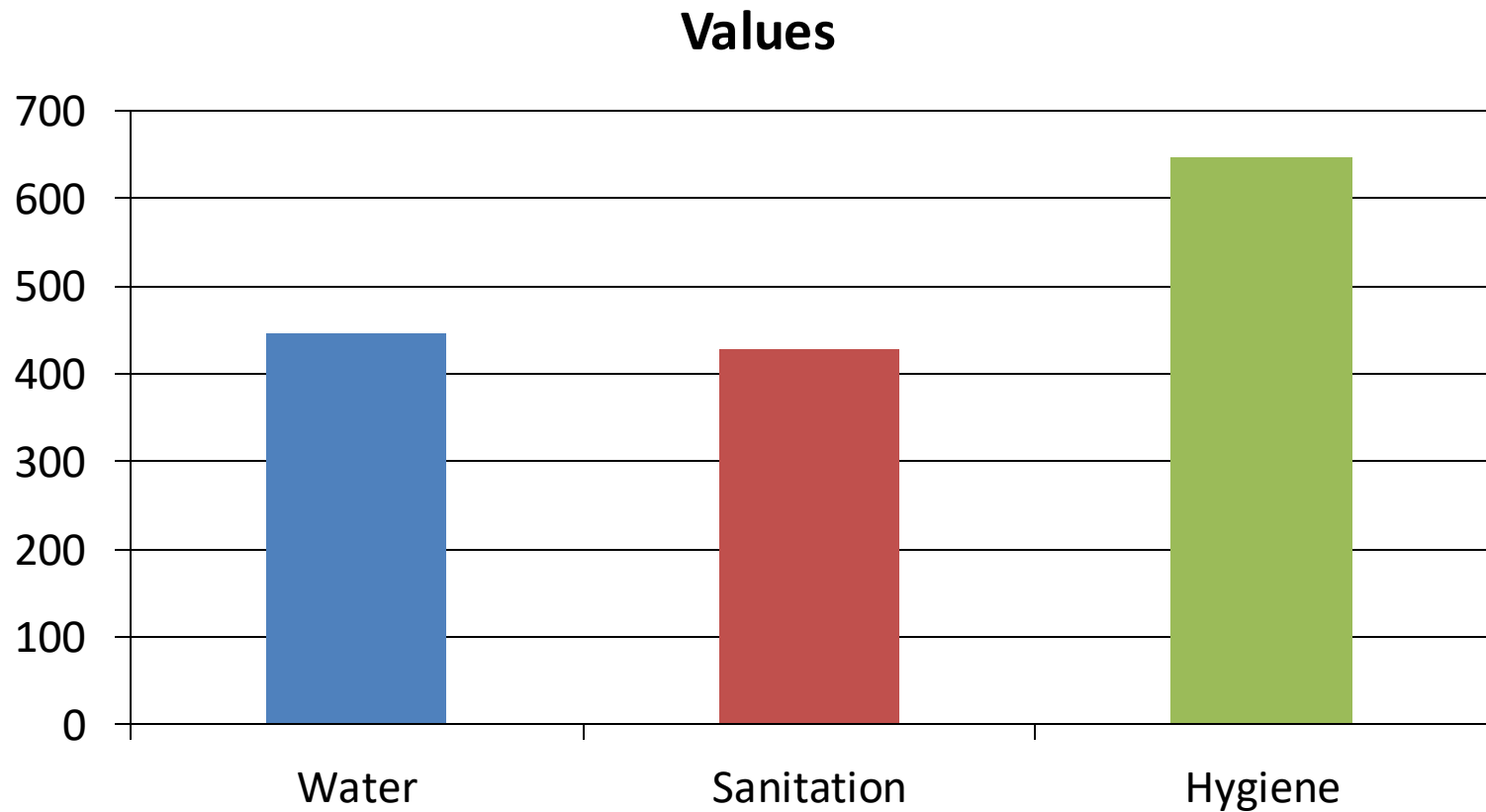
Values

- 447M children lack water in schools
- 427M lack sanitation
- 646M lack hygiene facilities

Inequality

- Rural and low-income regions most affected
- Major disparities across regions

Challenges vs. Policy Solutions

- Financing: Funding gaps remain significant
- Pollution, weak governance, infrastructure gaps

- Integrated water management
- Investment in infrastructure
- Global cooperation

Future Outlook

- SDG 6 not on track for 2030
- Acceleration required
- Key message: Urgent action needed globally to ensure safe water for all
