“To promote Erasmus students' awareness of their rights and obligations, each Erasmus student will receive an Erasmus Student Charter from their home university before leaving for the study period abroad. The Charter is a short information leaflet that tells Erasmus students what they are entitled to and also what they are expected to do during their secondment.”

“The **Erasmus Student Charter** outlines the basic entitlements of the Erasmus students, such as free tuition and full recognition of studies abroad. The **Charter** also specifies the main obligations of the Erasmus students, providing them with a concise idea of their duties in respect to both their home and host universities. It will be issued to all Erasmus students by their home universities before they leave for their study period abroad.”

It is possible to go from the airport to Athens by public transport (metro, bus, suburban railway) as well as by car and taxi.

b) **The metro Line 3 (Blue Line):** *the most comfortable... especially if your luggage has wheels or you got a trailer*

c) **The Suburban Railway:** *the definitely characteristic mode of transport of the first decade's 21st century Athens, inaugurated for the Athens Olympics 2004*

4. HOW TO REACH HAROKOPIO UNIVERSITY (*Charokopeio Panepistimio*)

LOCATION OF HAROKOPIO UNIVERSITY – (Erasmus ID code: G KALLITH 01)

Harokopio University is located in the **Municipality of Kallithea**, a municipality in the broad Athens area at the south-southwest of the Acropolis and Philopappos hill.

The Municipalities of Kallithea, Athens and Athens' area as well as around islands are parts of one of the thirteen (13) administrative regions of Greece, namely the **Region of Attica**.

The El. Venizelou Ave. was previously called Thisseos Ave. The name is still in use by many people.

The main gate is on *El. Venizelou Ave.* in the middle of a park, between *Evangelistrias Str.* on the N.E. and *Charokopou Str.* on the S.W.

The closest Metro Station (at ~8 minutes walking distance) is **TAVROS – El. Venizelos**, on Metro Line1 - *Green Line* Piraeus – Kifisia.

FROM TAVROS STATION ON METRO LINE 1/GREEN LINE

Getting off at TAVROS Station, you choose Exit to *Pan. Tsaldaris Str.*, Take *Agion Panton Str.* in front of you, to *Venizelou (Thisseos) Ave.*

Then, (there is a church on your right hand) turn left, and at the crossroads with *Charokopou Str.* you are at the southern corner of Harokopio University Campus.

Web-based lessons of Modern Greek, developed by the Institute for Language and Speech Processing (www.ilsp.gr) and offered free of charge to Greeks of the Diaspora or to foreigners, who wish to learn Greek and have no previous knowledge of the language. Based on everyday-life situations, which are supported by video and audio files with native speakers of Greek, these lessons help the user acquire the necessary language skills, in order to successfully communicate in potential communicative situations (e.g. visiting a doctor, going to a taverna, going shopping, telephone conversation etc.).

“Learning Greek on the Web” employs English as the support language, and is based on the language material of the multimedia CD-ROM series “filoglossia+”, which has been developed by the Educational Technology Department of the Institute for Language and Speech Processing (for more information, please visit <http://www.ilsp.gr/filoglossia+.html>). The basic features of the lessons are summarized below:
