2. **Utrecht University:** As a receiving institution will send its acceptance decision within 6 weeks after the deadline.

HAROKOPIO UNIVERSITY: As a receiving institution will send its acceptance decision within 5 weeks after the deadline.

3. **Utrecht University:** A Transcript of Records will be Issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

HAROKOPIO UNIVERSITY: A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

Modification or termination of the inter-institutional agreement can be discussed and agreed upon for each academic year. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given, in an official letter by the signatory. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2018 will only take effect as of 1 September 2018+1.


