How 'European Universities' will look like in 2025-2030?

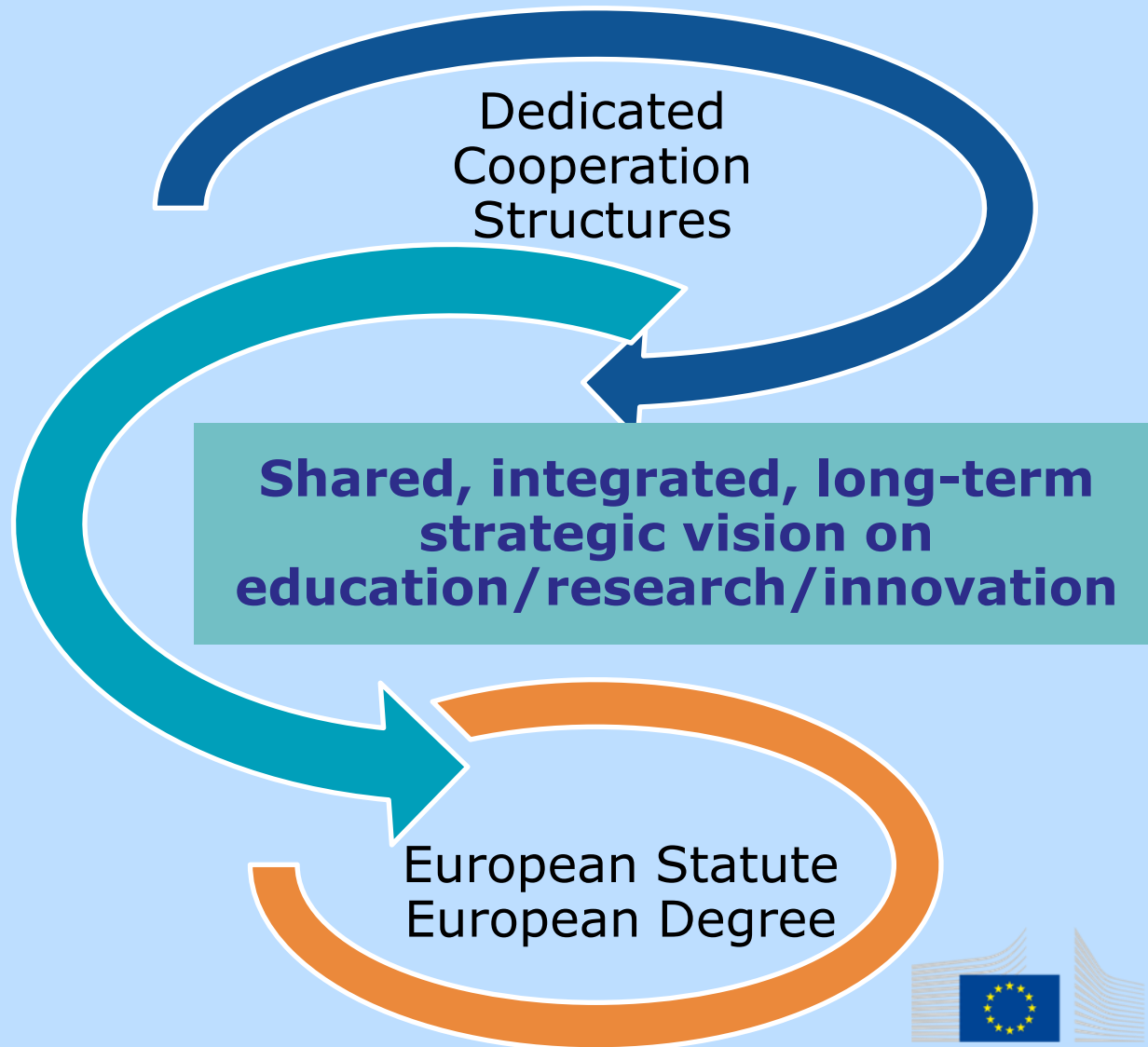

Testing phase 2019 and 2020

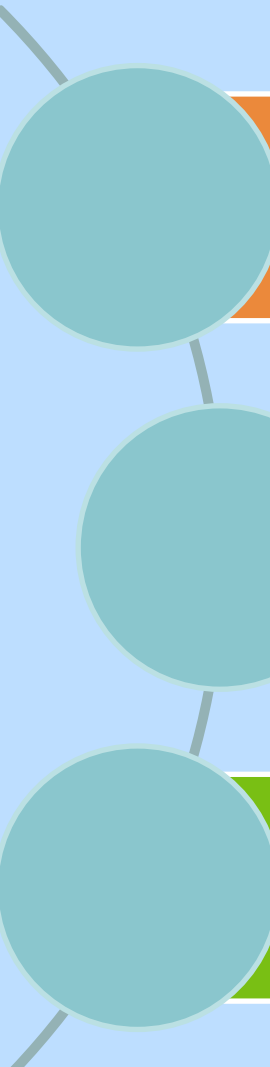
2 calls for European Universities launched under 2019 and 2020 Erasmus+ Work Programmes as centralised actions
