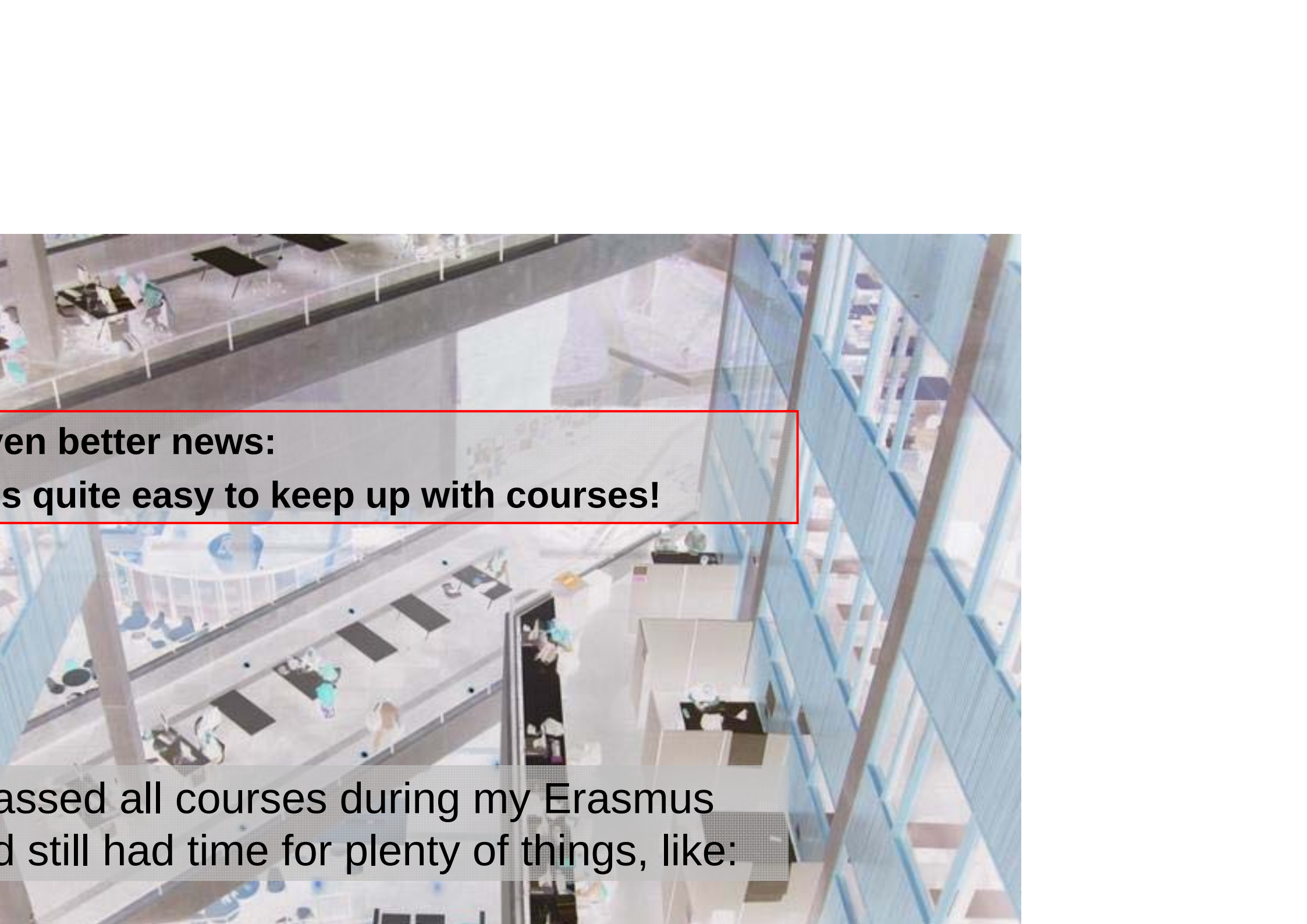




**Good news:
