

Harokopio University's Language Policy _ Incoming

- The language of Instruction in all the programmes is Greek.
- Tutoring or even teaching in English or French is offered to the Erasmus Students for specific Courses & Laboratory lessons. The Erasmus Candidate should contact the Departmental Coordinator and/or the Contact person for the specific Inter-institutional agreement, by preference before the submission of application.
- The Erasmus students would have reached the B2 level (CEFR – Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) in the working language (English or French). <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/resources/european-language-levels-cefr>
- For laboratory work and fieldwork, the Erasmus students are integrated in student team working in English or French.
- Classes of Academic English – English for Specific Purposes running during the Winter and Spring Semesters are open to Erasmus Students
- Harokopio University supports the Erasmus students to attend a Greek language course with allocation of ECTS Credits.
- The Erasmus Student wanting to attend the courses in Greek should have at least a B1 level (CEFR – Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) in Greek, as well as be prepared for specific Greek vocabulary and phraseology related to his/her field of study.
- The language of teaching and of assessment (as well as the mode of assessment) shall be proposed by the Applicant and clearly defined by the Erasmus & ECTS Departmental Co-ordinator at the moment of Acceptance.
