- Related to STA incoming: First contact before the mobility and the related arrangements should be done with the HUA's Faculty closer to the taught topic(s) or with the ECTS – ERASMUS Departmental Co-ordinator.
- Related to STT incoming: First contact before the mobility and the related arrangements should be done either with the HUA's Faculty closer to the training topic, or with the ECTS -ERASMUS Departmental Co-ordinator, in case of Faculty's training, and with the ERASMUS Office, for administrative personnel.

Harokopio University welcomes disabled students and staff. The Departmental Co-ordinator should be informed by the partner about the support needs of a disabled student or member of staff three (3) weeks before the Application deadline.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5 G KALLITH01] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
  - A Transcript of Records will be issued by the University of Cyprus no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement
  - <u>set by G KALLITH01:</u> Any modification in the clauses C E.1. as well as unilateral termination of the agreement, will be notified to the other party at last on September the  $15^{th}$  of the year 20xx and will take effect from the next academic year, as of 15 September 20xx+1.
  - set by CY NICOSIA01: In the event of unilateral termination of the current agreement, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September of the current year will only take effect as of 1 September of next year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
